- no a standardized approach to care
 often no category by sexual orientation or sexual behavior of participants in research

- · best health care practices are difficult to locate
- 1 risk for preventable disease, but do not receive preventative
- † risk for anal cancer and mental health concerns
- ↑ risk of HIV and STI infections, especially men of color ↑ risk for tobacco, alcohol, and drug use
